

# **GAL XLOKK PROFILE**

- The GAL Xlokk Foundation was founded by a group of local councils and private entities in the southern part of Malta.
- The Xlokk region holds a population of 109,023 inhabitants covering an area of 72.8km<sup>2.</sup> This foundation applied under the LEADER programme of the EU Common Agricultural Policy to become in 2010 one of the three Maltese registered Local Action Groups (LAGs) representing the southern rural region of Malta.
- A committee was formed up of 49% representing the Local Councils and 51% representing the private sector.
- The diversified actions, which are managed by the LAG will cover a wide spectra of the rural community activities such as rural development events, sports, culture and drama, rural infrastructure and other community well-being participation.
- The GAL Xlokk foundation developed a strategy for the Xlokk Region. This strategy embraces different actions, which have to be implemented until 2013. Each action will be advertised, promoted and procured. However information about these actions can be followed in one of these local councils: Kirkop, Luqa, Zurrieq, Qrendi, Ghaxaq, Birzebbuga, Marsaskala, Marsaxlokk, Qormi and Zejtun which are full members of the GAL Xlokk. It is foreseen, that more local councils, which make part of the Xlokk region, will become full members of this foundation.



## LEADER INITIATIVE

- The LEADER initiative, launched in the nineties with the aim of improving the development potential of rural areas focuses on bringing together the different public and private local actors. Malta, thanks to the financial allocation of about €3.8 million devoted from the Rural Development Programme 2007-2013 to the implementation of the LEADER strategies has started to put in place this innovative project.
- The LEADER approach is based on the crucial role of Local Action Groups (LAGs): a public/private partnership composed by representatives of the Local Administration and the private sector. The Local Action Group was in charge of coordinating the design of the local development strategy and nowadays, that this strategy has been accepted, it is being implemented. Representatives of the public sector such as Local Councils and other Government entities as well as representatives of social economic partners and other civil society organisations form these Local Action Groups.





## MESSAGE FROM OUR CHAIRPERSON MR. JOSEPH ATTARD



Welcome to this Seminar being held in Sofia and many thanks for your hospitality. Although the idea of the Leader dates back to the 90's, Malta did not take part in previous programmes such as Leader I, Leader II and Leader+. In fact we are the only EU member country with no previous experience in this type of programme. Contrary to the previous programmes, the Leader programme as we know it today forms an integral part of the Rural Development Plan (RDP) 2007-2013, as Axis Four of this programme. Given that this programme is one of the four axes of the RDP, the Maltese Government had to dedicate at least a minimum percentage of these funds to this axis. These funds then needed to be operated by non-profit making foundations in the form of Public-Private Partnerships which are known as Local Action Groups or LAGs.

LAG XLOKK officially started operating in mid-2010 and although we are still on a learning curve, I am pretty sure that we will succeed in this new adventure. I am very honoured to be the first Chairman of this Local Action Group which, in my opinion, has got all the capabilities and expertise required to run successfully this programme in LAG Xlokk territory, thus ensuring another Leader type programme within the next EU programming period, that is 2014-2020.

## MESSAGE FROM OUR MANAGER MR. SILVIO SCHEMBRI

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September 2010 the Foundation Local Action Group (LAG) XLOKK signed an agreement with the Paying Agency within the Ministry for Resources and Rural Affairs to start the implementation of it's Local Development Strategy in line with the Rural Development Programme 2007 – 2013.

By signing this agreement the Foundation LAG XLOKK has been officially recognised as a Local Action Group responsible to implement the LEADER programme for the South-East region in Malta. This agreement has a value of about €3 million and all these funds should be committed by 2013.

Unfortunately our region is still new-fangled to sustainable and green investment in fact the majority of the Country's investment associated with pollution such as; industrial estates, power stations, fish-farms and freeport amongst others can be found in this region. This programme is the silver lining in this rather dark picture.





















## LUQA LC - HAL FARRUG, FAMILY PARK

















- The applicant will present the BOQ prepared by the architect in the first stage together with the relevant MEPA application or permit (if required)
- Preference shall be given to projects which do not require a MEPA permit


