

- 1. Area based local development strategies for sub regional territories;
- 2. Local private-public partnerships (named as Local Action Groups) designing and implementing those strategies;
- 3. Bottom up approach (participatory approach) with decision making power to LAGs;
- 4. Multi-sectoral / integrated design and implementation of strategy
- 5. Innovative approaches;
- 6. Cooperation projects;
- 7. Networking of local partnerships.


# LEADER IN PORTUGAL

- The beginning of way back...




## 1991-2007: 15 YEARS OF LEADER IN PORTUGAL



# LEADER 2007-2013 IN PORTUGAL



- ▶ PIC → LEADER "mainstreamed": integration of the LEADER methodology in RD programs of the EU member states
- $\rightarrow$  In PT  $\rightarrow$  3 RDP (53 LAG)
  - Portugal mainland: 47 LAG (PRODER)
  - +
  - Azores islands: 4 LAG (PRORURAL)
  - Madeira islands : 2 LAG (PRODERAM)



# LEADER IN PORTUGAL - EVOLUTION



- ➤ More formatted program → Less flexibility for territorial adjustment
- ➤ More centralized program → Less autonomy for LAGs
- Less space for creativity and innovation

### WHY?

### 1. LEADER has been unknown

(and... we fear what we don't know)

# 2. LEADER requires complicity (meaning autonomy + responsibility)

(at local and between decision making levels)

## 3. LEADER is sharing power (do decide)

(who wants to loose power?)

### 4. LEADER is about animation

(animation is not festivities)

- 2. Local Development Strategies → Broad, integrated but realistic!
